## Submitting a Proposal

Fremantle Arts Centre welcomes proposals for exhibitions, events and residencies for its 2008/09 program from individual artists, groups of artists, curators and organisations. The Centre is open to gallery-based, off-site and online proposals. Proposals which take into consideration the Centre's distinctive site or engage with the City of Fremantle Collection are particularly welcome. Proposals can be submitted at any time. Key programming meetings are held twice a year following the deadlines of 1 February and 1 August. Emailed proposals are not accepted.

Proposals need to include a recent CV for each participant; a brief outline of your project; an indication of preferred space/site and timeframe if possible; and a non-returnable disc of images. Detailed information to accompany the images is essential. Gallery plans are provided on the Centre's website.

## Support by Fremantle Arts Centre for Projects

Fees for participants and other project costs are met by the Centre. When work is sold Fremantle Arts Centre takes a commission and administers sales.

## Background to Fremantle Arts Centre

Fremantle Arts Centre is a multi-arts organisation uniquely situated in a magnificent neo-gothic building. Part of the City of Fremantle, the Centre's program of exhibitions, events and residencies brings together local, regional, national and international artists working with concerns that have currency with the Centre's audiences.

Fremantle Arts Centre has four galleries – the Main Gallery, the Hall Gallery, Gallery Three and the Kathleen O'Connor Gallery. The Centre also has one residential studio (the Moores Apartment) and five non-residential studios – the Moores Workshop, the Green Shed Studio, Office Studio One and Office Studio Two, and the Thelma John Lounge. A fifth gallery is managed by the Curator of the City of Fremantle Collection. The Centre presents a program of live events ranging from the intimate to those attracting capacity audiences of 2,300.
