These roles involve teaching classes and workshops, on times and dates agreed with the Learning Coordinator.

This is a rolling recruitment period and applicants are encouraged to apply at any time.

Role Duties

- Deliver course content as advertised by Fremantle Arts Centre and previously agreed with the Learning Coordinator in a professional, stimulating and encouraging manner.
- Work closely with the Learning Coordinator to prepare course outline and descriptions, as well as material and equipment requirements.

Eligibility

Applicants must:

- Possess the right to live and work in Australia.
- Demonstrate excellent communication skills, a sound knowledge of their specialised art practice and significant experience in facilitating art-based workshops and classes.
- Have a general knowledge of workplace safety practices for working in art studio environment.
- Demonstrate experience in supervising children and hold a current Working with Children Check (for Kids' Courses applicants).

Desirable:

- Applicants have their own arts practice.

How to Apply

Interested parties should submit a one page covering letter and a CV (max. 2 pages), to demonstrate their suitability for the role.

Applications should be submitted in Microsoft Word or PDF format and emailed to learning_fac@fremantle.wa.gov.au

You may also be required to supply a current; Working with Children Check; and proof of qualifications, certificates and any appropriate training relevant to the role.
